Study Modes:

Full-time Studies

Full-time studies allow trainees to accumulate full credits as defined by the curriculum. As such, full-time enrolled trainees may pursue tertiary education at other academic institution after completion of their level 3.

Skills Development Training

Skills Development is for persons with extensive working experience but does not have a formal academic qualification who wants to:

- Improve their skill sets to provide better performance in their current positions
- Equip themselves with a qualification required to advance to higher positions

Level 1 and 2 is completed in the same academic year with level 3 completed the following year:

- Level 1 = 8 weeks
- Level 2 = 8 weeks
- Level 3 = 8 weeks
- Trade Test Preparation = 2 weeks

Skills Development training carry fewer credits as trainees are exempted from generic modules. Assessment for level 1 and 2 is facilitated internally while the final Level 3 external assessment is conducted through the NTA.

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) is a process whereby, through assessment, credit is given to learning which has already been acquired over the years.
